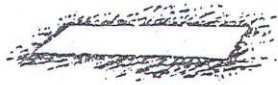


Monument Types



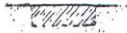
The individual Grass Marker and the individual Bevel Top Hickey Marker can be used to identify individual places in conjunction with a family monument. Grass Markers are flush with the ground. Bevel Top Hickey Markers are raised.

SET FLUSH WITH GROUND

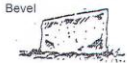


The double Grass Marker and double Bevel Top Hickey Marker are used for two burial spaces. Example – husband and buried side by side.

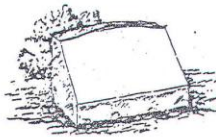
Sectional View

SLANT FACE MARKER



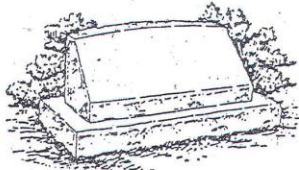
Double Slant Face Marker used for a two side by side grave spaces.

Top Nose

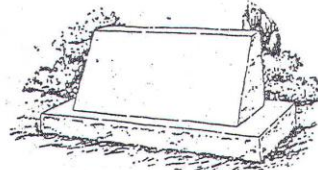

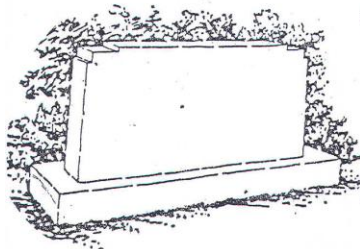
Side View



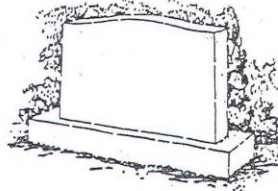
Double Slant Face Marker on a base.
