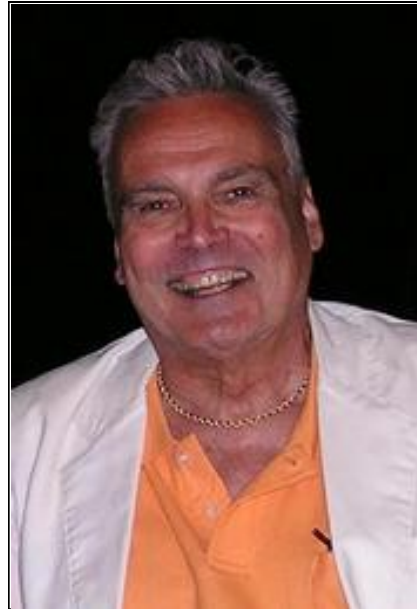
Gilbert L Shisler
