

## Glenn M. Auble

He belonged to the Fox Valley Men of Harmony, and sang in a barbershop quartet, even after developing cancer in recent years. His passion was really his family. He married his childhood sweetheart Barbara (Bobbi) Sue Rees of Bartlett in 1958. He and Bobbi built their own house where they raised 2 children and instilled in them the love of the outdoors and strong family values. They shared many years of enjoyment with their grandchildren and explored travel and the arts together. He was preceded in death by his wife Bobbi Auble, daughter Robin McKinnon parents Donald J.
