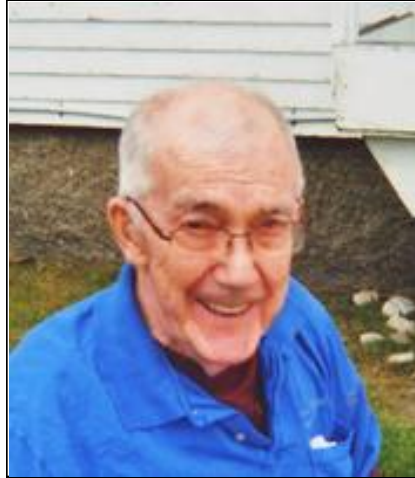


Anthony Memorial ~ Frank A. Welsh & Sons
