On his return from the war, Wesley re-engaged in his love of the timber industry. He spent his working career as a Mill Foreman/ Superintendent. Throughout his working life and into his retirement years, Wesley spent many of his days enjoying his love of the outdoors. He was an avid fisherman and hunter who shared his passion with his children and grandchildren, leaving them with a great respect and appreciation for the great outdoors. He thoroughly enjoyed spending days at the race track, watching his two sons and then his two grandsons race as the "Lawson Brother's Racing Team"
