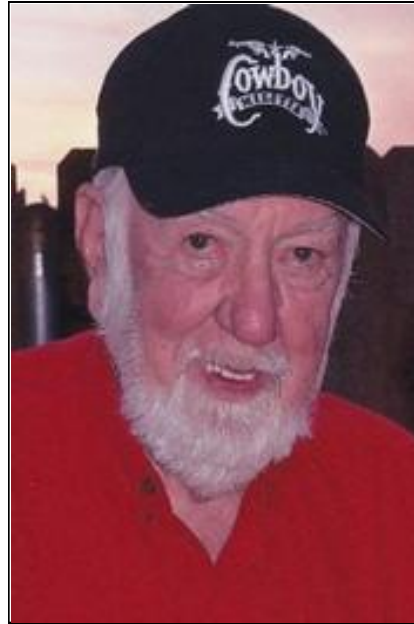
Dean David (DD) Brittian
