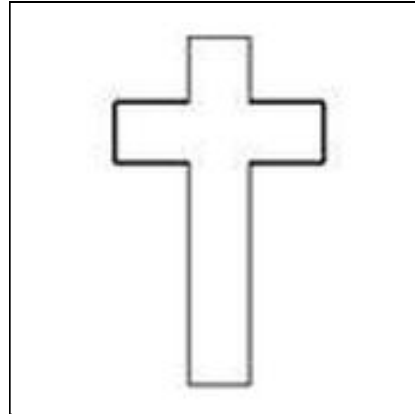

## Marorie Briley

Longtime Redding resident, Marjorie L. (Lieurance) Briley, died July 15, 2013 from cancer. She was 89 years old.

Marjorie was born in Yreka, CA and moved to Redding when her father accepted a job at the Redding Record as a linotype operator.



She graduated from Shasta High School in 1942, and quickly joined the War effort working in Redwood City for several years instead of pursuing a career in music, which had been her dream.

Returning to Redding after WWII, she worked for McDonald's Lumber and Redding Yellow Cab, where she met and married her husband, James, who preceded her in death.

She was a lifelong member of the St. Joseph's Parish Family and a member of the Altar Society and Legion of Mary. She was also a member of the Women's Auxiliary of the Shasta County VFW. She chose to live her life simply and with grace one day at a time. She leaves behind her children Susan (Briley) Margulius and James Briley, her grandchildren, Netanya, Jordan, Jessica, Joshua, Mikayla and David along with five and a half great grandchildren.

Visitation will be at 6:00 p.m. on Monday, July 22 and a rosary will be recited for her at 7:00 p.m. at Allen & Dahl Mortuary in Redding.

A celebration of her life and a Mass of Christian Burial will begin at 10:00 a.m., Tuesday July 23, 2013. Internment is at the Shasta County Veteran's Cemetery.
